

TROOP 182G CAMPING LIST

Consider clothing and outerwear made of synthetic fabrics (Polypropylene, Thermasilk, Thermax, etc.) which transport moisture and dry quickly, unlike cotton.

Troop's Gear

Responsibly: Patrol Leader(s) and Quartermaster(s)

Sleeping

- Tents, Stakes (2 scouts per 1 tent)
- Drop Cloths (Tarps for under Tents)
- Lanterns
- Rope & Clothespins
- Hammers

Cooking

- Pots and Pans
- Dish Soap, Dish Towels, Wash pan
- Plates, Cups, Bowls
- Plasticware
- Cooking Utensils / Can Openers / Cutting Board
- Fire Starter
- Propane / Cook stove
- Fire Extinguisher
- Dining Fly / Poles / Tie Downs
- Food
- Paper Towels
- Water Container
- Garbage bags
- 30' – 50' paracord if raising a bear bag

Campsite

- Flags with Stands
- First Aid Kit
- Toilet paper (just in case)
- Hand sanitizers
- Tools (bow saws, hand axes, shovels, etc.)

Individual's Gear

General List

- Sleeping bag & Sleeping pad
- Pillow
- Lightweight poncho or Rain Jacket
- Flashlight + batteries
- Pocket knife (Totin' Chip Required!)
- Toiletries (Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Shampoo)
- Sunscreen
- Clothing (one set/ day, +1)
- Long pants
- Long shirt
- Extra socks
- Extra shoes (no open toe)
- Mess kit w/ utensils and cup
- Water bottle (canteen)
- Day pack (e.g., "book bag")
- Chair (?)
- Insect repellent (no aerosols)
- Scout Handbook
- Pen & paper
- A watch
- Compass
- Whistle
- Two masks
- Prescribed medications
- Ensure inhalers are full!

Summer Camp

- All the above (General List)
- Dirty clothes bag
- Towels and wash rag
- Shower shoes (flip-flops, shower only)
- Bathing suit and towel

Winter Camp
